In Georgia legislation, HB 301, the anti-dog fighting bill, unanimously passed the Senate in a rewritten form after going before the Senate in several forms on March 28, 2008. It will now go to the Governor for his signature. In the state of Georgia, the law already requires that all dogs adopted from shelters or rescue groups be spayed or neutered.

It is the Chemical capture of companion animals which gives animal control people after training the ability to use chemical capture rather than waiting for a Vet to arrive. A third bill receiving little resistance is the TN animal abuser registration, tracking and verification act. The Companion Animal Initiative of TN will direct UT Vet School to conduct a study of animal shelters in TN and make recommendations.

Delegate Report: The AKC Canine Legislative Department has been renamed the AKC Government Relations Department

Old Business: Pet Fair has ten breeds signed up to attend. Will be held May 10th from 11-2:00 at the Walker County Agricultural Center.
