Meeting Adjourned at 8:30.



General Meeting Minutes

Feb. 9, 2010

Meeting was called to order by Jane Price at 7:35 pm

Minutes from the Board Meeting were read.

Corresponding Secretary Report was given by Mary Menozi. It is time for the Lifetime Achievement Awards Nominations to be submitted to AKC.

There was a motion to nominate Jean Fournier for the Lifetime Achievement Award in Conformation. M/S/P

Treasurers Report was distributed. Ashley is out of town. There was a question about a check for Show Venue but this check has been voided and that has not yet appeared on the printout.

Committee on Education and Training reports there are class taking place at Stockdales. Jerry Davis states there will be classes in Cleveland if they have enough people sign up. At this point they do not have enough people signed up to move forward with that class. Preregistration is required and must be in by Saturday.

Legislative Committee reports that a new ordinance has been passed in Chattanooga that dogs may not be placed outside on a chain between the hours of 10pm and 6am due to too many dogs being bred while out on a chain.

Be aware laws are being passed to squeeze out dog related freedoms.

Show Committee Report by Carlene Gilstrap. Judges are approved for one day. Waiting on other approvals. Trophies are running behind due to not having a chair for that committee until this week. Please be aware and respond quickly when asked about trophies.

New Business: There is a proposal to make a change in the By-laws for the purpose of clarification of the process of voting in new members. Proposed change was distributed. There was a Motion to make the change as distributed and Second. Motion Passed by a vote of 27 yea, 0(zero) nay.

Mendy Bryson brought to the clubs attention the 14 month battle of a dachund owner/breeder with New York and their animal control officers. Again the admonition that we must all comply with laws that have been passed but we do not under any circumstances need to allow animal control officers on our property or in our homes unless they have an official warrant to enter our premises. People are encouraged if animal control officers come to your home to step outside your door and close the door behind you to speak with them. Do not allow searches of your property with proper authorization. Caution is always the best policy for law abiding citizens.
