BOARD MEETING MINUTES

August 2, 2010

The meeting was called to order at approximately 7:10 PM at O'Charley's in Chattanooga.

Corresponding Secretary:

- Mary will discuss thank you notes received and the K9 College Cruise at the general meeting.
- A request for a donation to the AKC Humane Fund has been received. This item will be addressed after the show in October.

Legislation:

- At the general meeting, Jane will be discussing the PUPS Bill now pending. She will provide a hand-out for the members.

Membership:

- Two members (Gigi Nash & Laura Oakley & family) had requested their memberships' be renewed late. The board agreed to reinstate them. It was agreed that we must address late renewals in more detail.

Nominating Committee:

New Business:

Various board members will investigate possible new meeting locations, such as: Old Fort & Mountain View Inn in Cleveland, Jenkins in East Ridge and 212 Market in Chattanooga. All will report back to Jane before the next general meeting. It may be that, in the future, the board will be meeting before the general meeting at the Golden Corral.
- It was agreed that we should book Harrison Bay State Park now for next year's picnic on July 16, 2011. Jane will contact Neke Burke.

GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

August 10, 2010

The meeting was called to order at approximately 7:30 PM at The Golden Corral in Chattanooga.

Program:

- Veterinarian Laura Williams of the Animal Hospital of Signal Mountain gave a presentation on vaccinations. She discussed core and non-core vaccinations.

Corresponding Secretary:

- The Board Meeting minutes were read.
- The K9 College Cruise will occur in February.
- Recently received thank you notes were noted.

Treasurer's Report:

- Ashley distributed the latest report. M/S/P to accept the report as written.

Education and Training:

- A new handling class begins Tuesday, August 17th at Tri-State Exhibition Center in Cleveland. Class times are 7-8 Beginners & 8-9 Intermediate/Advanced. Mats will be provided.

Membership:

- Two readings for new members were done.

Legislation:

- PUPS Bill - Jane provided information on the PUPS Bill now pending. Presently it has 98 co-sponsors in the TN House of Representatives. This means there are already 98 'yes votes' for the bill. We, as a club, should be concerned about the bill as are the Sportsmen's group and the NAIA. In this bill, the definition of a breeding female is a 4 month old bitch. In addition, the bill will place restrictions on internet sales of animals. The TN Federation of Dog Clubs has composed a letter that can be sent to our representatives to protest the bill. Jane noted that sponsors of the bill are trying to quietly pass the bill without a lot of publicity.
- Other legislative news – San Francisco has passed a law against the sale of dogs within the city. Memphis is attempting to pass a mandatory spay & neuter law.

Show News:

- The same food vendor used last year will be at this year's show. Concern was expressed about the long waits for food that occurred last year. This information will be referred to the vendor.
- Carlene provided premium lists for the show.
- Show date – Carlene mentioned there are several shows in the area that draw exhibitors from our show, currently AKC week #37. It was proposed that we consider changing our show date to AKC week #38 in order to improve the entry counts. Numerous items need checking before making the change; i.e. Is Camp Jordan available? & Will AKC approve the change? It was noted if we make the change, it must be done soon due to judges selection. A club vote will be required for this change. More information to follow.
- Carlene provided posters to members to pass out to businesses for display.

GENERAL MEETING MINUTES CONT.

- CKC Shirts – Members helping at the show should be wearing club shirts to make it easier for exhibitors and spectators to get questions answered. Let Marilyn know if you need a shirt.

Hospitality:

- Neke was congratulated on a successful picnic this year.
- Neke reported the preferred date for next year's picnic (July 16th) is not available. She has booked the following Saturday, July 23rd from 4-8PM for next year. Some concerns were expressed about conflict with other shows.

New Business:

- Jane needs to order a CKC throw. Let her know if you need one and she will order it for you.
- The *Hamilton County Herald*, an on-line publication, interviewed Jane for an article on the CKC with regard to our upcoming show. The article has been included in our newsletter. It was a positive article and it was suggested we write a thank you note to them.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:50 PM.
