The 2011 National Show Committee has arranged a breeder's education program open to **all dog fanciers and breeders** at the 2011 PCA National in Chattanooga, TN. Attend this one day seminar and learn the important facts about knowledge based breeding and puppy development.

Dr. Battaglia's seminars and materials provide breeders with an easy method for understanding their pedigrees. It is based on pedigree analysis and breeding methods based on new technology. With two pedigrees breeders can visually see the strengths and weaknesses of a dog's trait.
